“Think” Questions – Answers:

1. They see that the stone is moved away, that the tomb is empty, the wrappings used to cover Jesus’ head rolled up by itself. They think someone has taken Jesus.
2. We don’t know why the evidence of the empty tomb was enough for the beloved disciple to believe.
3. She recognizes him when he calls her by name.
4. Peter was probably confused; he may have gone to tell more people about the empty tomb. He was with his friends, talking about what he saw that morning; they feared the Jews. Reassure, calmed.
5. He doubts them; he wants to see Jesus before he believes. He believes when he touches Jesus’ wounds.

Share with your child that the stories of Jesus are not just meant for believers 2,000 years ago. Sacred Scripture is just as alive and meant for us today! Jesus gave his life for his friends and for us today!

Questions within this section – Answers:

1. Open-ended
2. Everything Jesus does obeys God’s plan. Specifics include his acceptance of his beatings, his humiliation, Crucifixion and Death. He continues to walk his disciples through their fear and disbelief. Jesus’ entire life, but especially during Holy Week and Easter, is an example of obedience to God.
