Dear Friends,

Jeremiah explains that those who trust in the Lord will bear fruit like a tree planted beside gentle waters. Paul teaches that because Christ was raised from the dead, we can hope in our own resurrection. Jesus preaches that those who suffer now will be rewarded in time. We look forward in hope to better days, holier lives, and a more respectful way of life among all our brothers and sisters.

These Scriptures contain words that can change your life. Read or listen to them; they are for all of us, seeds for eternal life.

SYNOD ON SYNODALITY

Pope Francis formally launched a two-year consultation process leading to the 2023 "Synod on Synodality," on Sunday October 10th, with a call to "look others in the eye and listen to what they have to say."

Catholics taking part in the 'synodal path' should strive "to become experts in the art of encounter; not so much by organizing events or theorizing about problems, as in taking time to encounter the Lord and one another."

The synodal path should be a time devoted to prayer and adoration; "listening to what the Spirit wants to say to the Church." It should be a time to "look others in the eye and listen to what they have to say, to build rapport, to be sensitive to the questions of our sisters and brothers, to let ourselves be enriched by the variety of charisms, vocations and ministries."

The Vatican announced in May 2021 that the "Synod on Synodality" would open with a diocesan phase lasting from October 2021 to April 2022.

A second continental phase will take place from September 2022 to March 2023. The third, universal phase will begin with the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops, dedicated to the theme "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission," at the Vatican in October 2023.

Preliminary discussions are being held with our parish and Pastoral Council, and preparations on an Archdiocesan level are under way. Further information will be forwarded to you as we learn them.
