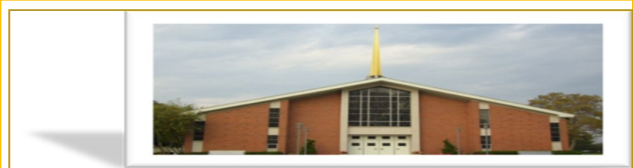

A PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

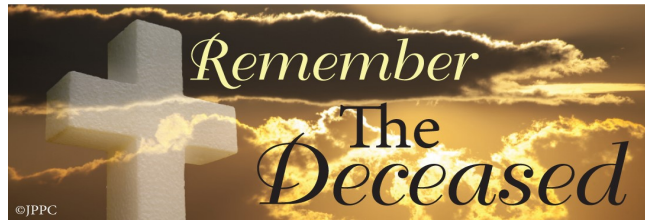
