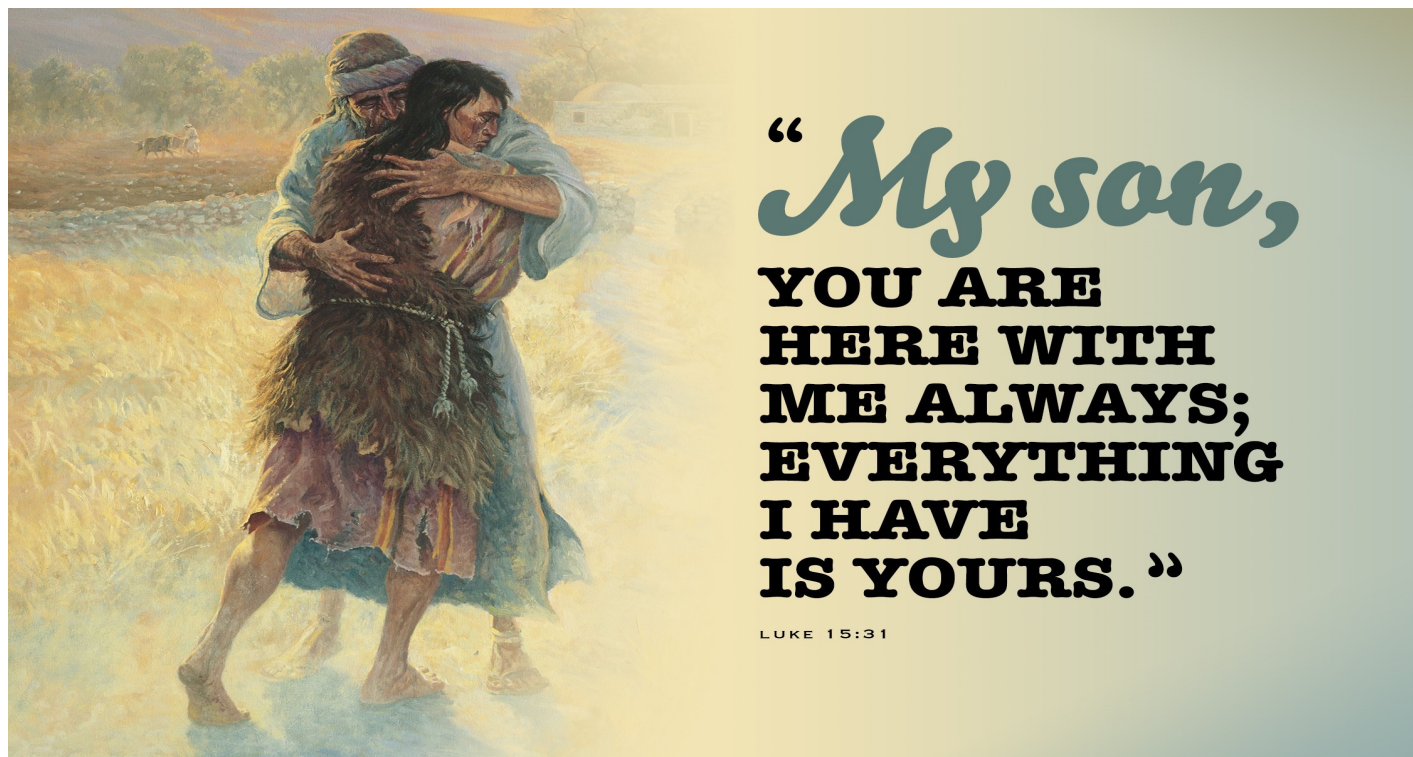

Dear Friends,

Today we share one of the most familiar Gospel passages known to Christians. "He was dead and has come to life again." The father in the Gospel this morning reveals a God who forgives because of His great love. These words are familiar to us because in a very short time, we will hear them again from the lips of the angels and the disciples.

Listening to the parable this morning, as well as the words from Joshua and Paul, reminds us of how God transforms us all, from the believers reaching the Promised Land, to sinners who turned away from those who love them, to all of us today.

It is a real comfort to know that, even when we feel lost in sin, our God is waiting to embrace us and forgive us when we return with repentant hearts.

Today is traditionally called Laetare Sunday, a name derived from the first word of the proper Introit of today's Mass, "Rejoice, Jerusalem." This turns Her focus now on the Passion and Death of Jesus as we prepare for the holiest week of the year.

Continue to pray for the most hardened sinners and for the release of the poor souls in purgatory. Your prayers, united to the Passion of Jesus will be powerful in these holy days and you and your family will gain many graces by your efforts to help other souls get to heaven!

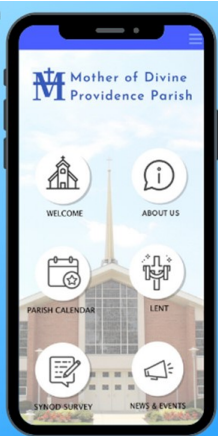

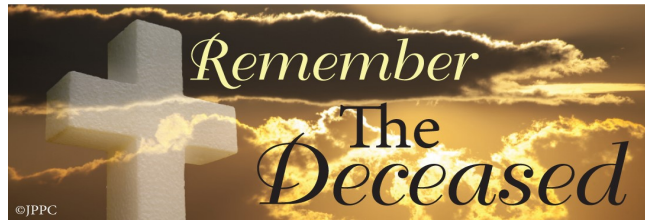

ST. MARY'S POLISH EASTER FOOD

We are happy to announce the return of our annual St. Mary Polish American Society Easter Food Sale. Food items will include: -Babkas (cheese, cinnamon crumb, or raspberry cheese) for \$15 each from L&M Bakery in Delran, NJ; - Pierogi (potato, potato cheese, or sauerkraut) for \$9 per dozen from Polka Deli in Port Richmond in Philadelphia; Kielbasa for \$8 per pound from Czerw's in Port Richmond. The deadline for food orders will be Wednesday March 30th so our suppliers have enough time to process our orders.
