

Dear Friends,

The Lord moves in mysterious ways, and we hear of those ways in the readings given to us today. People are cured merely by lying in Peter's shadow as he walks the streets of Jerusalem.

John, the author of Revelation, though imprisoned on the island of Patmos, sees, and hears the Lord and feels His tender touch. The evangelist tells us the Risen Lord was able to enter a locked room, where He gave the Holy Spirit by His very breath. His words to Thomas remind us that we ourselves have come to know the Lord without physically seeing or hearing Him.

The Easter Season gives us all kinds of opportunities to glimpse at the faith the early Christians and then to rekindle that faith that was so dynamic and fruitful.

In this spirit of the growing Church, this Sunday, join me in welcoming Andrew Patton, a Villanova student, who will be spending the summer working as a servant leader for Camp Wojtyla, an outdoor Catholic youth camp in Boulder, Colorado, that ministers to middle and high school students looking to strengthen their faith. Camp Wojtyla is funded mostly through donations, and part of his responsibilities as a counselor is to fundraise to support the program.

He will speak to us after the last Prayer; explaining the mission of Camp Wojtyla, asking for prayers, and directing parishioners to further information for donations we may feel called to make. The missionaries will make themselves available to speak further with any parishioners who would like to know more.


