Dear Friends,

Continuing the Easter celebration, we hear the accounts of the period following the resurrection. The Sanhedrin forbade the apostles to preach in the Lord's name, but they took the reprimand as a badge of honor.

The Visionary John saw the angels and elders praising and worshipping the Lamb. Before Ascending to the Father, Jesus appeared again to His Disciples and called upon Peter to care for His flock.

In a span of a few weeks, we have heard Simon Peter deny that he even knew Jesus three times, and today, we hear his confession of love three times for the very man he denied.

Our lesson is quite vivid- Jesus will always call you back no matter how far you have fallen or how often! Take these words with you as you go your way. Share the hope and joy of resurrectional life, and you will become a missionary to all creatures of God's Word and Divine Providence.

On May 4th, Wednesday, we will be hosting an Archdiocesan event: Missionary Disciples Workshop. We welcome people from around the Archdiocese to our home and wish them our best wishes for the success of this workshop. Archbishop Perez will offer the 8 am Mass in Church with Bishop McIntyre and we certainly welcome them both to our Church.

OFFERING "THE SIGN OF PEACE" DURING MASS

Beginning Sunday May 1st, the invitation to offer *The Sign of Peace* will be resumed at all Masses at Mother of Divine Providence parish. By its nature the Eucharist is the sacrament of peace. At Mass, this dimension of the Eucharistic mystery is eloquently expressed during the Communion Rite when we offer each other the peace of the Risen Lord. When properly invoked and given to others in the celebration of Mass, this simple human gesture is lifted to the realm of the sacred.

In the United States, the Conference of Catholic Bishops has decided *The Sign of Peace* is reverently expressed by shaking hands only with those who are seated nearest to you, your immediate neighbors in the congregation. While the Sign of Peace is being given, it is acceptable to say: *The peace of the Lord be with you always*, to which the reply is *Amen*.

We recognize that shaking hands with those nearest you may be uncomfortable for some. In that case, a simple verbal exchange of peace may be offered.

Other expressions of Christ's peace, for example, waving to others seated at a distance from you or using the secular peace sign ("V") are gestures which are incompatible with the intended expression of communion with those nearest to you. Such gestures give rise to disorder in

the congregation and should be avoided.

Offering the Sign of Peace at Mass remains an option which the priest may exercise at his discretion. Thank you for observing the proper use of this gesture during Mass.

Be at peace this week and may God's blessings come upon you and your family,

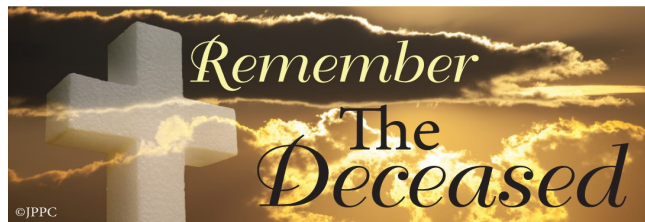
