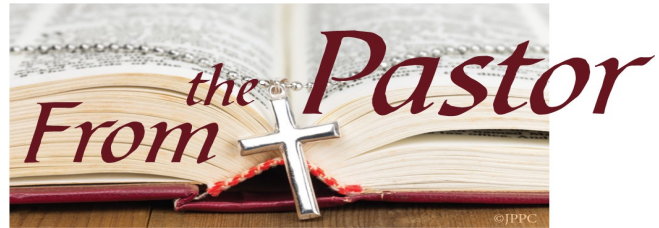

Dear Friends,

We hear Saint Stephen in the first reading, bravely testifying to his faith in the face of those who are about to stone him to death. Such courage! Such boldness!

John writes about his vision of the Lord coming in judgement at the end of time. Jesus prays that all may be one as He and the Father are One.

As the Easter season begins to conclude, our prayers should focus on the gifts we bring to this parish. Each week, you stand here, like St. Stephen, as witnesses to the power of the paschal mystery: the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

To be missionary disciples, all one must do is be the same witness outside these walls, in your homes, in the marketplace and at work.

Our model, our exemplar is Saint Stephen, the first Christian martyr, to stand before a murderous crowd, including Saul of Tarsus, and not back down from proclaiming his faith.

A new missionary disciple comes before us today in the person of Chris Anderson, a young parishioner, who is being called to work with young people. He will speak to us today about how he hopes we can help him and encourage him to engage people in the faith freely given and freely accepted.

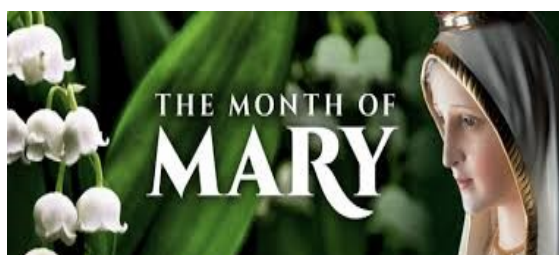

I have been a lifelong MDP Parishioner, graduating from MDP School in 2014. I have served as an altar server, lector, and sacristan throughout my grade school and high school years. I attended Archbishop Carroll High School, graduating in 2018. I graduated in 2021 from West Chester University, and just recently completed my master's degree in Catholic Pastoral Ministry at the University of Dallas this past May.
