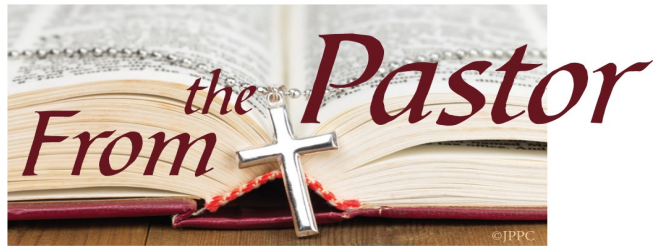

FROM OUR SEMINARIAN CHIKE

The simple meaning of the trinity is relationship. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit are 3 persons in a relationship. The core of what makes them whole and complete is the same but the way they relate to each other is different. Therefore, the mystery of the trinity is a call to relationship to make us whole and complete. Relationship is what God is all about: Father, Son and Holy Spirit summed up in love.

Father Who is the Creator, the Son Who is the Redeemer and the Holy Spirit Who is the Gift (Sanctifier and love). Instead of asking why three persons, let us rather ask: Can we be a creator of happiness in others, can we be a redeemer of those in need, can we help others stay sane and guide them in time of need?

All our efforts and striving as persons are towards union and we are always reaching out to union. Our craving for relationship, hugs, and love, is because we are a people of the trinitarian lineage. God is community and we are made in the image and likeness of God so we must reflect our ancestral origin. Our search for satisfaction and happiness and fulfilment is a clear sign of reaching out to unite to something outside ourselves which is the triune God.

Our life has meaning in who we are in relation to others. The feeling of lack of relationship is a terrible state to be, the most crippling moment in our lives is when we felt alone, abandoned, and rejected. We have all felt the deep pain of separation: death or distance.

We are made in the image and likeness of a God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. No matter how little we may know about the Trinity, we can say without hesitation that the Three Persons exist in relationship to one another.

God becoming man in the person of the Son was the most selfless thing we are called to do. Love is our DNA. Let us get out of ourselves and reach out to others and see a need we can fulfil in others' lives. Every day we wake up is a tremendous potential to love and we cannot love ourselves alone. Like the trinity, our life is a story of love: can we strive to be inseparable in our love with others around us: words and actions?

We are part of a society that fights, resists, fears and rejects love via different shades of individualism and promotion of self-sufficiency, unforgiveness, judgmental attitude, self-righteousness, and divisive mindsets of all kinds.

Let us sing with our action and words:

"And they'll know we are Christians by our love, by our love,
yes, they'll know we are Christians by our love.

We will walk with each other, we will walk hand in hand; We will walk with each other, we will walk hand in hand; And together we'll spread the news that God is in our land."

Therefore, let us go against the societal values and reach out to others around us. A call to the ministry of presence: just be there for someone, reach out in love and compassion.

Let us, through our love for one another, participate in the life of the Trinity, because to love is to know, and we know through relationships, being with people, giving ourselves to people, receiving and giving love and care.

Let us Go and teach people around us about the trinity by loving.
