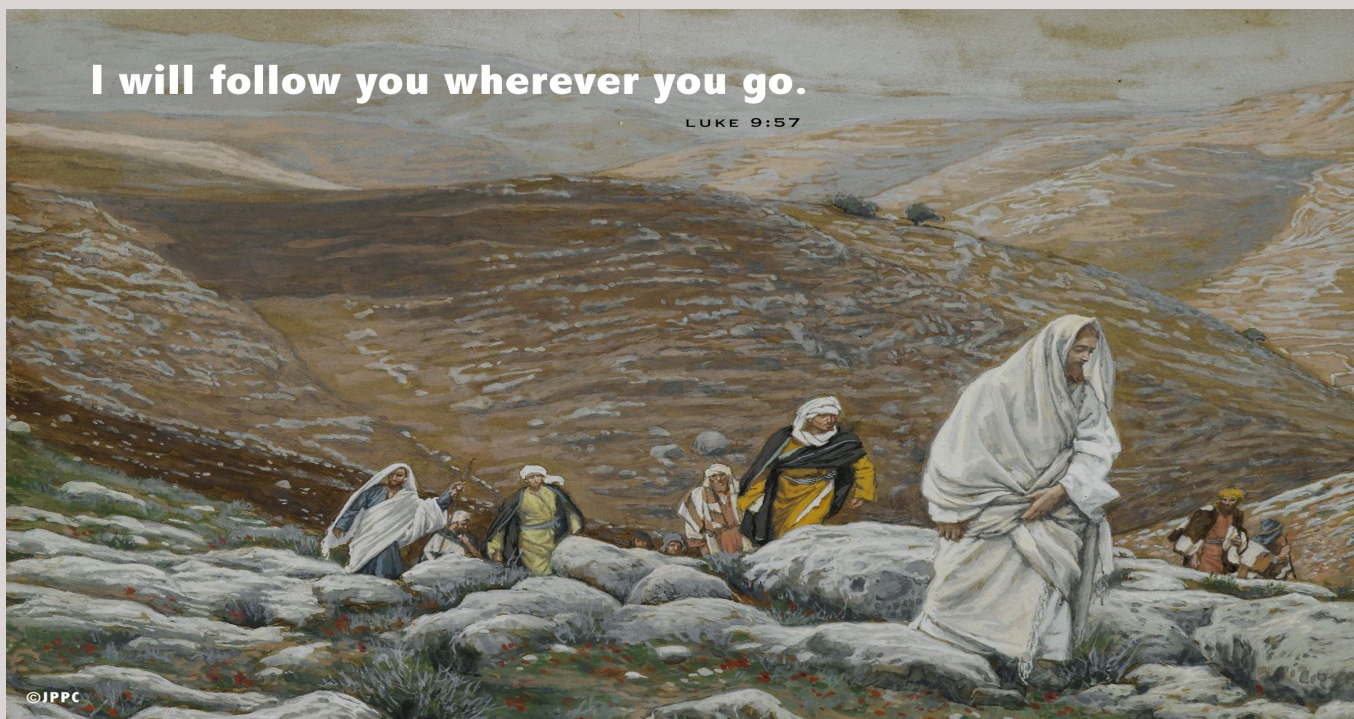

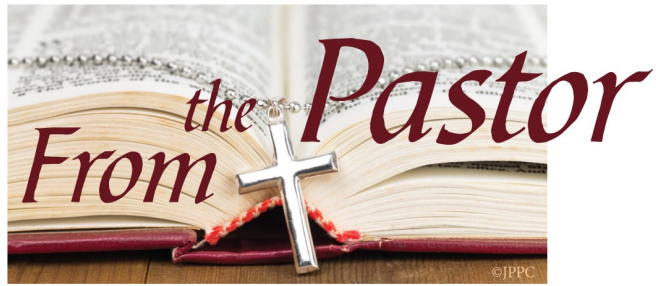

### FROM OUR SEMINARIAN CHIKE

With the past two precious celebrations of The Trinity and Corpus Christi it will be fitting to take a journey into the heart. "A new heart I will give you, and a new spirit I will put within you; I will remove from your body the heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh" (Ezek 36:24). It is a journey of the heart since love sits in the heart.

Friday was the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart. This is about the invitation to come to Him and to open our own hearts: that is to change our human hearts to be more like the heart of Jesus. It is about an invitation of grace as a gift given not earned, is about this reckless gift of grace. The reason behind our YES to Christ, that yes to trust faith and love.

The Sacred Heart is meant to be transformative. We beg for that transformation. Jesus' heart made Him cry for the lack of love in the streets of Jerusalem. The transformation in a practical sense means to place our heart side by side with the heart of Jesus. Whenever we fail to align our heart and treasure the love that beats in His heart for us, His heart is wounded. Let us recall the incident on the cross, the piercing of His side on the cross was humanity reaching out to the heart of Jesus, the seat of love again, Jesus did not relent as blood and water gushed out. He lays His heart open before us as an example of how to live our lives. The best way to love Him in return is to open our hearts and let Him love us. He suffered, He died and He literally laid down His life and set His heart upon us. It is our turn to open our hearts and share Christ's love. Every person needs to find his "center" in Jesus' Sacred Heart.

We are aware there is no feast of Jesus' sacred brain. Therefore, pause for a moment of silence, feel the beating of your own heart, but more deeply, the beating of a trustworthy presence in the Blessed Sacrament.

Finally, Let us embrace the gift and responsibility that come from opening our hearts to the love that flows from the humble heart of Jesus, When we accept this invitation we will re-echo like Thomas "My Lord and my God." (John 20:28).
