

Dear Friends,

Moses speaks to a sinful people in the first reading, pleading with them to keep the Lord's commandments as they repent with their whole heart and soul. In the Gospel, a scholar of the law of all God's commandments, goes one step further, asking Jesus what he must do to inherit eternal life.

Realizing that loving one's neighbor is at the heart of the answer, he askes Jesus who his neighbor is. It is in this context that Jesus tells the parable of the Good Samaritan, asking the questioner who was the true neighbor.

Today's Gospel is one of the most loved for all Christians. Reflect on these words when you get home and through the week. Find the Story in your Bible and leave it open to that story, realizing that others may happen upon it and share in the wonder of this commandment for them. And, by reading it, may we come to understand who our neighbor is, who is our brother or who is the other we ought to love with all our heart.

FROM OUR SEMINARIAN CHIKE

We left off with the question: Who is my neighbor? This question brings up the interplay of identity and impression: who people are and who people are to us, which is tightly connected to our relationship with God and others around us. Who we are is our identity, and who others are is the impression others make on us or what we think of others. There is only one thing proven to change the meaning of identity and impression. Love is the answer to who is my neighbor.

Love is the big word here: love leads us back to God, to know who my neighbor is: we are created in His image, and we are His by adoption, meaning that who I am or who the other person is, must be founded by Christ-like identity and impression. If Christ is holy His image and adopted child is the same.

However, we are divided in various ways: Levite and Samaritans, White and Black, vaccinated and unvaccinated, Democrats and Republicans, etc. These divisions can affect relationships we have with people. Permit me to say that we need Love. Love is the joining ring: we are hooked by love as the main joint and this love is Christ. Christ is asking us who do you think I am? What is your impression about Christ and His creatures who co-share in His image and likeness and adopted sonship? Amidst all our identities we are of Christ, the other person is the Christ-like.

This message speaks to us directly as DISCIPLES UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF JESUS. Amidst all our identities we are children of GOD, that is Christ-like. What impression we have about people doesn't matter in this family of Christianity. Our identity as a child of God is the only important identity and impression that exists.

During Mass we come to this altar of Love every day for the renewal of our identity card. Just like we would not want our driver's license or state ID to expire, we don't want our Christian identity to expire. Come every day to celebrate the Eucharist, go to confession, come to adoration, represent Christ on the streets as MISSIONARY DISCIPLE. "Approach any victim you encounter, pour oil and wine over his or her wound and treat him or her with mercy." When we encounter anyone, may our actions speak compassion and mercy. Let the person say "you are the Christ." When we encounter someone look at them beyond our difference and speak with our actions and words saying to the person you are the Christ.

Our goal today and forever is to bear the identity or the impression: You are the Christ. STAY CHARGED WITH DUI i.e. DISCIPLE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF JESUS... YOU have chosen the better part.


