FROM OUR SEMINARIAN CHIKE

In our last reflection we left off at “YOU HAVE CHOSEN THE BETTER PART.” The missionary discipleship is a conversion experience that comes with choices. The will power to choose Discipleship Under the Influence of Jesus, that is to allow oneself to be remade slowly in the image of the living God, to open our hearts to God that God’s own story is retold in the disciple. Every day our life’s journey is “love’s endeavor, love’s expense,” our dream is the outpouring of self for the life of the world. The reflection of apostolic zeal that spreading the Good news is to teach people about God.

The Choice is to push against the force that holds us back: the forces to stay away from the miracle that happens at Mass every day in the Eucharist. We must force prayer because there is a force pushing us away from prayer. We must force an Encounter with Jesus because there is a force pushing you away from encountering Jesus. You cannot encounter Jesus without forcing yourself to push against the force that keeps you away. When you wake up for Mass or pick-up your rosary or to come to confession, you feel this force. We choose to push against that force.

A DISCIPLE UNDER THE INFLUENCE of Jesus has the courage to turn a spark into a flame because the disciple’s story is presented in the way the stories imitate, or repeat, the Christ event, as divine love takes place anew in the flesh of our human existence.

Christianity is neither a social club, nor a social media group and never an association. It is a life style of doing God’s word. It is that choice of detachment that will attach us to the center which is Jesus. There is only one proven way to attach ourselves to Jesus: PERSONAL PERSISTENCE IN PRAYER: Hold tight to PPP. As we release the tight hold on PPP.

We cannot be the caller and the responder. Prayer is listening, in the dark place of our prayer: a dark place is prerequisite for a greater future, it is a time to stretch our spiritual muscles, learning to be patient and humble. Prayer is surrendering to God that gives life. PERSISTENCE in PERSONAL PRAYER is a passageway to purity. It is an entrance into intimacy with Jesus rather than an answer to a need. We need the tender touch of our Lord to lead us away from a hardening heart to one that is broken before Him. PERSISTENCE in PERSONAL PRAYER is God’s bridle of brokenness to bring us under submission and surrender. Our desires are not useful until they are prayed. When we are persistent in personal prayer to God, the heart can no longer be adamant to do its own thing. It is in our persistence that divine restoration takes place. This is the Lord’s way. He doesn’t break us and leave us to suffer in pain and discomfort. It is out of our persistence that He pulls us close to His heart in compassion and love. Moreover, prayer is both an event and a process that the Holy Spirit is still with us by conforming us into the image of Christ. It is the process of our pride decreasing and our humility increasing.

PERSISTENCE in PERSONAL PRAYER is God’s way to blessing and change. He breaks our will and restores us into the wisdom of His will. He breaks our spirit and restores us into the security of His Spirit. He breaks our pride and restores us into His humility.
