


Transportation Ministry

FROM OUR SEMINARIAN CHIKE

Prayer is surrendering to God that gives life.

We need the tender touch of our Lord to lead us away from a hardening heart to one that is broken before Him. With PERSISTENCE in PERSONAL PRAYER to God, the heart can no longer be adamant to do its own thing. It is in our persistence that divine restoration takes place. This is the Lord's way. He doesn't break us and leave us to suffer in pain and discomfort. It is out of our persistence that He pulls us close to His heart in compassion and love. Moreover, prayer is both an event and a process. The feast of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit is still with us by conforming us into the image of Christ. It is a process, our pride decreasing and our humility increasing.

PERSISTENCE in PERSONAL PRAYER is God's way to blessing and change. He breaks our will and restores us into the wisdom of His will. He breaks our spirit and restores us into the security of His Spirit. He breaks our pride and restores us into His humility. APPLY PPP TODAY!


