MDP SHORE UP THE FUTURE

As of July 31, 2022, we have received \$185,655.50 in donations from 226 families for our 2020 Year 3 Challenge – renovations to the Parish Offices and creation of our Family and Youth Center. We thank all those who continue to contribute to this Appeal.

RENOVATION UPDATE

We have recently completed the 2nd phase of this project. Improvements include new HVAC system for the 1st floor, removal of step and new ceiling in front meeting room, removal of built-in AC wall units in both meeting rooms, new paint and carpeting in meeting rooms, hallways and offices on parish side, and electrical distribution upgrade and LED lighting upgrade throughout the parish office area. Total cost for these renovations amounted to \$129,175. Phase 1, completed last summer, involved renovations on the 2nd floor of the Family & Youth Center side enlarging an office area for the DRE, asbestos abatement, new carpets and paint in 3 office areas and new carpets in hallway on entire 2nd floor and 2 stairways. That phase totaled \$50,070.40. The next phase will focus on renovations to the former convent side of the building, making improvements to accommodate Family and Youth classes and activities.
