



### Dear Friends,

"The Lord has revealed His saving Power!"

We have listened most attentively to the readings from Mass, given to us by the Church for our understanding and a deepening of our faith. He reveals Himself to us in marvelous ways and Paul says with great confidence and assurance that "if we are faithful, He remains faithful, for He cannot deny Himself." 
