

Dear Friends,

Today is the last Sunday of the liturgical year: Christ the King.

This Solemnity is a meditation on the reality of who Jesus is: "He is the image of the invisible God...for in Him were created all things in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible...He is the head of the body, the Church...For in him all the fullness was pleased to dwell, and through Him to reconcile all things for Him, making peace by the blood of His cross through Him, whether those on earth or those in heaven."

"He is the image," hidden in the Bread of Life, of the invisible God! Today is the day we remind ourselves of what and whom we have, especially before us at Mass. And at Mass, we become aware of Jesus' Power to forgive, to be compassionate and to save the most unlikely sinners.

The key phrases in the Gospel give us a wordsplash into the reality of Jesus, the King of our hearts: "Are You not the Christ?" "Have you no fear of God?" "Today you will be with Me in paradise."

Advent is near my friends, commit yourselves to an hour of adoration before the Blessed Sacrament each week, on Tuesday. He waits for you here to help you encounter His Peace and His Father's Glory!

My prayers are for you and your families this week. May you and your families share peace and love, compassion, and forgiveness with each other, especially around the table. As we do each year, we will be distributing bread, graciously donated from *LeBus*, to all who come to Mass on Thanksgiving morning.
