GUIDE TO CONFESSION

Prayer before Going to Confession

Come Holy Spirit into my soul.

Enlighten my mind that I may know
the sins I ought to confess, and grant
me your grace to confess them fully,
humbly, and with a contrite heart.

Help me to firmly resolve not to
commit them again. O Blessed Virgin,
Mother of my Redeemer, intercede
from me through the Passion of Your
Son, that I may obtain the grace to
make a good confession. All you
blessed angels and saints of God,
prayer me, a sinner, that I may repent
from my sins, and that my heart may
be forever united with yours in eternal
love. Amen.

RITE OF RECONCILIATION

Welcome

Priest: (Welcomes the penitent.)

Priest and Penitent: In the name of the
Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy
Spirit. Amen.

Confession of Sins

Penitent: Bless me Father, for I have
sinned.

This is my first confession.

OR

It has been ___ weeks/months/years since
my last confession.

These are my sins. (Tell the priest your
sins with honesty in number and kind.) I
am sorry for these and all my sins.

Priest: (Gives a penance to make up for
your sins and to change your heart.)

Act of Contrition

Penitent:

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having
offended you, and I detest all my sins,
because I dread the loss of heaven and
the pains of hell, but most of all because
they offend You, my God who are all
good and deserving of all my love. I
firmly resolve, with the help of your
grace, to confess my sins, to do penance,
and to amend my life.

Absolution

Priest: I absolve you from your sins in
the name of the Father, and of the Son,
and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen.

Proclamation of Praise and Dismissal

Priest: Give thanks to the Lord, for He is
good.

Penitent: His mercy endures forever.

Priest: (Tells the penitent to go in peace.)

Penitent: Amen. (Make the sign of the
cross.)

***Penitent** should pray or do your penance as
soon as possible, preferably immediately.*

EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE FOR A GOOD CONFESSION

Before receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation, it is recommended that you take time to examine your conscience and bring to mind that which you are going to confess. Remember that all mortal sins must be confessed. Withholding a mortal sin is in and of itself a mortal sin.

1. *I am the Lord your God: You shall have no other gods before me.*

Did I fail to love God, to make God first in my life, to thank Him, or trust Him as He deserves? Did I fail to pray? Have I denied my faith? Was I careless in saying or not saying my prayers? Have I been involved in practices or rituals which are foreign to a Christian mentality?

2. *You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.*

Did I curse or swear? Did I use God's Name in vain, carelessly, by blasphemy? Have I used foul language or jokes?

3. *Remember to keep holy the Sabbath.*

Have I deliberately missed Mass on Sundays or Holy Days of Obligation? Did I arrive at Mass late or leave early without good reason? Have I been to Communion at least once a year? Did I receive Holy Communion in a state of

mortal sin? Have I been to confession recently? In any of my previous confessions, did I lie to or deliberately conceal something from a priest? Did I do unnecessary work on Sunday?

4. *Honor your Father and Mother.*

Do I honor and obey my parents' just requests? Do I respect my brothers and sisters? Do I respect others in lawful authority, especially teachers? Have I talked back? Did I fail to help at home or to spend time with my family?

5. *You shall not kill.*

Did I give into feelings of anger or jealousy? Did I keep hatred in my heart? Did I fight, give a bad example, or cause scandal? Have I abused drugs or alcohol? Have I had or in any way permitted or encouraged homicide, abortion, or euthanasia? Have I attempted to harm myself or attempted suicide?

6. *You shall not commit adultery.*

Did I consent to someone looking at me, touching me, or talking to me impurely or inappropriately? Was I immodest in dress or behavior? Did I objectify a significant other or spouse in any way? Did I look at pornography? Did I masturbate? Did I have premarital sex? Did I commit adultery? Did I use artificial contraception? Did I live

chastely according to my state in life (married, single, or ordained)?

7. *You shall not steal.*

Have I stolen what is not mine or vandalized property? Have I cheated on tests or homework? Did I waste time at work?

8. *You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.*

Have I lied or gossiped? Have I talked unkindly about others? Do I always tell the truth? Did I reveal secrets that should have been kept confidential? Am I critical, negative, or uncharitable in my talk?

9. *You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.*

Have I consented to impure thoughts and desires? Have I encouraged impure actions or conversations? Have I lusted after someone? Did I neglect to control my imagination or thoughts?

10. *You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.*

Is my heart set on and preoccupied with earthly desires and possessions? Am I greedy, envious, or jealous of what others have?

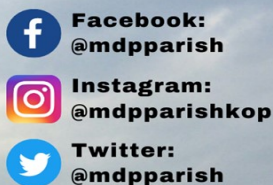
