FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROTT

The Greek word Epiphany means appearance or manifestation. First, the angels revealed Jesus to the shepherds. In our Church, the Feast of the Epiphany celebrates Jesus' first appearance to the Gentiles, represented by the Magi. Traditionally it has been held that there were three wise men (due to the three gifts), having the names Melchior, Caspar, and Balthazar. It is most likely that they came from Persia, an empire to the east. Furthermore, the term "magi" could refer to priests, sages, or even astrologers. This last option seems plausible due to their interest in a special star.

The magi came to Jesus and worshipped Him and brought gifts. Each of us has time, talent and treasure to offer for the greater honor and glory of God. The challenge for us is to discover those gifts. Most of us have gifts buried within us that the Lord wants to tap. The church started with humble beginnings. The little that we have and use for the greater honor and glory of God will be multiplied in a unique and special way by our loving Father. Do not be afraid to discover and use your gifts.
