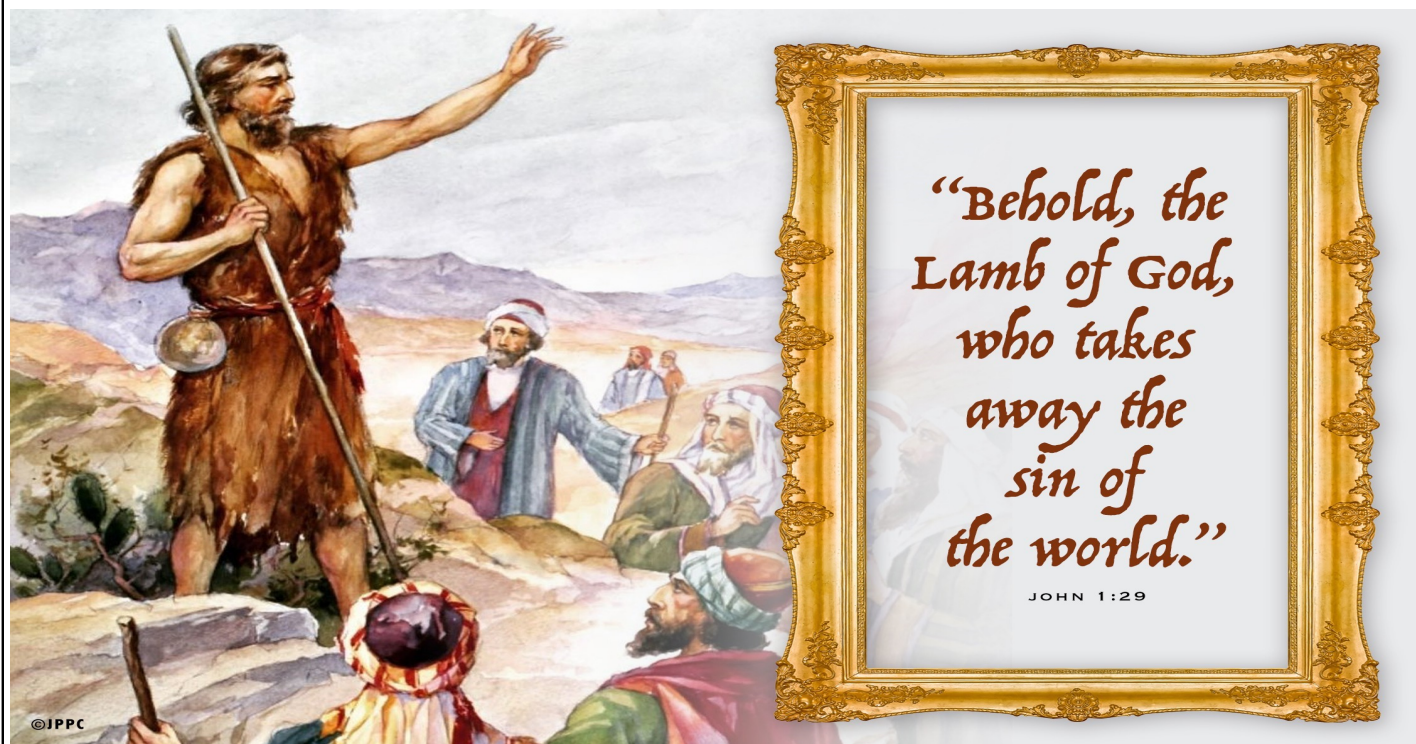

IN OUR PARISH

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROTT

When I was in the seminary in 2008, I had the pleasure of attending a rally for youth when Pope Benedict XVI was in New York as well as attending a Mass at Yankee Stadium. The seminarians had a great affection for Him because he articulated the teachings of our Catholic Faith with great clarity and made the faith come alive in our hearts.

According to a close friend of Pope Benedict, Dr Michael Hesemann, "He was so far away from being a strict, resolute prelate but always, even with his biggest opponents, open, kind and friendly ... Benedict did not only speak about God's love and mercy, he practiced it. But love and understanding did not mean compromise for him. He never betrayed the truth for just a foul compromise".

Integrity was very important to Benedict because integrity was the heart of the Ministry of Christ. Benedict stated in 2012 that "God's Law is his Word, which guides man on the path of life, releases him from the slavery of selfishness and introduces him to the 'land' of true freedom and life. For this reason, in the Bible the Law is not seen as a burden, an overwhelming limitation, but as the Lord's most precious gift, the testimony of his fatherly love, of his desire to be close to his people, to be their ally and write with his people a love story."

Pope Benedict challenged us to allow our hearts and minds to be purified so that we may live in conformity with Christ. He knew that an authentic faith was an important witness to the world and he challenged the entire church to follow Christ and teach all that he commanded. May Pope Benedict and all of the souls of the faithfully departed rest in peace.

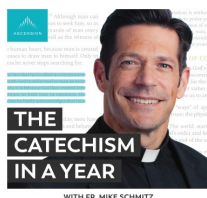

LITTLE PANTHER BASKETBALL PROGRAM
