FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROTT

As we celebrate Catholic Schools Week, we are reminded that education is more than imparting knowledge for the sake of a successful career but educating people on how to live as Jesus taught us by loving God and our neighbor. We thank our staff and teachers at MTC school for their service to our children and our community. We also thank our parents, volunteers, benefactors, and students.

The one differentiator that Catholic schools can offer is to teach about hope, not just a moral code (though morality is fundamentally important). In an article *Taking Hope Back to School*, Dr. Kilbane states that "Christian hope is not some vague, circumstantial belief that 'the future will be better than the past.' Rather, it is a virtue that combines a desire for something and the expectation that it will be received. More specifically, Christian hope is a desire for divine union with God and the expectation of eternal happiness through it".

1 Peter 3:15-16 says, "Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope, but do it with gentleness and reverence". As Christians, we know that our education is never ending as we can never exhaust the mysteries of our faith. We pray that our catholic education, whether received in a catholic school or through parish religious instruction, will allow us to share our hope in Jesus Christ to a world that desperately needs authentic love and beauty.

Please take time to thank God for the Catholic faith that you have received, through the witnesses of others and through your education. You have great reason to hope. 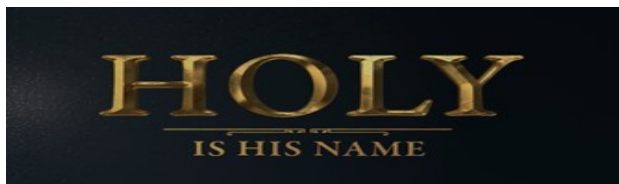

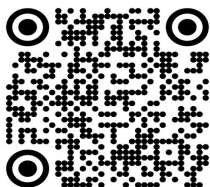
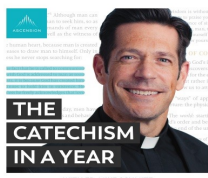
