### MDP SHORE UP THE FUTURE

As of January 30, 2023, we have received \$198,055.50 in donations from 229 families for our 2020 Year 3 Challenge – renovations to the Parish Offices and creation of our Family and Youth Center. To date, we have spent \$172,745.40 on renovations including an enlarged office for the Director of Religious Education, several enlarged rooms for youth gatherings, new HVAC throughout both sides of the first floor of the building, upgraded electrical throughout the building, improvements to the front meeting room, and new carpeting and painting throughout much of the areas. ## IN OUR PARISH

### FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROTT

*"You are the salt of the earth"*

As much as we talk about having food with lesser amounts of sodium, we know that we cannot eliminate salt all together. Salt gives flavor to most things that we eat and often goes unseen.

One of the wondrous gifts of our faith is seeing the flourishing of various saints. The Month of February is black history month. One of the great lesser known saints in the life of the Church is St. Josephine Bakita. Her feast day is February 10<sup>th</sup>.

Born in southern Sudan in 1869, Josephine was kidnapped at the age of 7, sold into slavery and given the name Bakhita, which means *fortunate*. She was sold several times until she ended up with Italian government employees in 1883.

Two years later, she was given to a man named Augusto Michieli. Bakhita became babysitter to Mimmina Michieli, whom she accompanied to catechism classes led by the Canossian Sisters. While Mimmina was being instructed, Josephine felt drawn to the Catholic Church. She was received into the church in 1890 and took the name of Josephine.

When the family returned from Africa and wanted to bring Josephine, she refused to go. During the ensuing court case, the Canossian Sisters and the bishop of Venice intervened on her behalf. The judge concluded that since slavery was illegal in Italy, she was legally free for five years.

Josephine entered the Institute of St. Magdalene of Canossa in 1893 and made her profession three years later. She assisted her religious community through cooking, sewing, embroidery, and welcoming visitors at the door. She soon became well loved by the children attending the sisters' school and the local citizens. She once said, "Be good, love the Lord, pray for those who do not know Him. What a great grace it is to know God!"

St. Josephine had every right in this world to complain but was drawn to the truth, goodness, and beauty of Christ. Be encouraging and hopeful in your faith journey to others, and like Josephine, we are called to be "Salt of the Earth".

### **FAST & ABSTINENCE AND OTHER ACTS OF PENANCE FOR LENT**

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, and on all the Fridays of Lent & Good Friday. Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light.

All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions as well as Lenten education programs. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended.

All are encouraged to participate in Operation Rice Bowl which has aided countless hungry persons here in the Archdiocese as well as throughout our nation and our world.

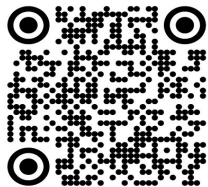
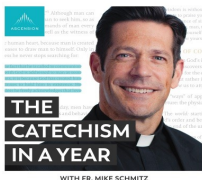
