MDP SHORE UP THE FUTURE

As of February 5, 2023, we have received \$199,660.50 in donations from 229 families for our 2020 Year 3 Challenge – renovations to the Parish Offices and creation of our Family and Youth Center. IN OUR PARISH

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROTT

Reflection on Matthew 5: 17-37 – What to do with your Eye and Hand.

Jesus says in Matthew 5 – “For if your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away” and “if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away.” What do we do with these passages?

The Dogmatic Constitution on Divine Revelation (Dei Verbum) from the Second Vatican Council states, “Sacred Scripture is to be read and interpreted in the same Spirit through whom it was written”. The sacred scripture contains many different styles of literature and due to the different types of literature, there are different “senses” of sacred scripture. There are many different literary types within scripture, including history, narratives, poetry, parables, wisdom literature, and apocalyptic writing.

The first goal is to determine the literal sense of the text within sacred scripture. The literal sense of scripture means what the author intends to say, not “literally” in the modern sense of the word. In this passage, Jesus is using hyperbole or extreme exaggeration to make a point. The deliberate destruction of parts of the body for non-medicinal purposes would be evil. The important reality that we can take from this passage is that sin is destructive for everyone, both the sinner and everyone affected.

If you are interested in further information, St. Thomas Aquinas stated that “All other senses of Sacred Scripture are based on the literal.” The spiritual sense consists of the allegorical, the moral, and the anagogical. The allegorical sense emphasizes that the Old Testament signifies what is to be fulfilled in the new. The moral sense of Scripture challenges us to take the moral teachings in Scripture and live them out in our lives. The anagogical sense is where we view the events and words in Scripture as leading us to our true homeland, the Kingdom of Heaven.

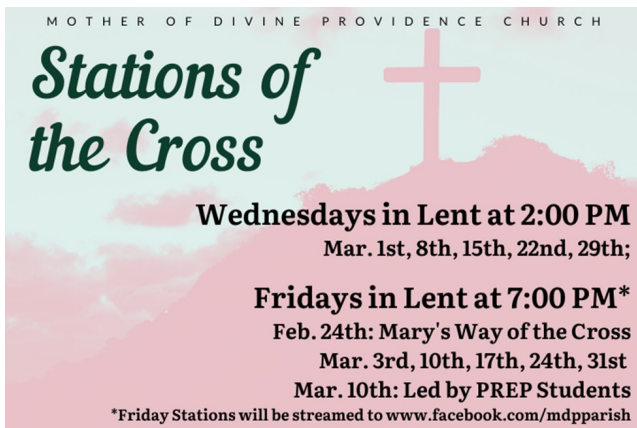

**FAST & ABSTINENCE AND OTHER ACTS OF
PENANCE FOR LENT**

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, and on all the Fridays of Lent & Good Friday. Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light.

All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions as well as Lenten education programs. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended.

All are encouraged to participate in Operation Rice Bowl which has aided countless hungry persons here in the Archdiocese as well as throughout our nation and our world.

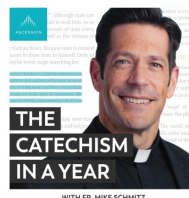
