


CATHOLIC CHARITIES APPEAL

MDP SHORE UP THE FUTURE

As of February 12, 2023, we have received \$199,965.50 in donations from 229 families for our 2020 Year 3 Challenge – renovations to the Parish Offices and creation of our Family and Youth Center. To date, we have spent \$172,745.40 on renovations including an enlarged office for the Director of Religious Education, several enlarged rooms for youth gatherings, new HVAC throughout both sides of the first floor of the building, upgraded electrical throughout the building, improvements to the front meeting room, and new carpeting and painting throughout much of the areas. More renovations to the Family and Youth Center side are planned in the future. Thank you to all those who continue to contribute to this Appeal.



FAST & ABSTINENCE AND OTHER ACTS OF PENANCE FOR LENT

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, and on all the Fridays of Lent & Good Friday. Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light.

All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions as well as Lenten education programs. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended.

All are encouraged to participate in Operation Rice Bowl which has aided countless hungry persons here in the Archdiocese as well as throughout our nation and our world.

IN OUR PARISH

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROTT

As we get ready for Ash Wednesday, it is good to think about what we want to experience or get out of the Lenten season. Please remember that the purpose of Lent is not to give up something so we can show our strength or resilience but to allow the sacrifices, passion, and death of our Lord to permeate our hearts. The church constantly reminds us that our faith involves engaging our hearts and our bodies.

Pope Francis invites us to think about Lenten practices to draw closer to the Lord. In his Lenten message in 2019, he stated:

"Fasting, that is, learning to change our attitude towards others and all of creation, turning away from the temptation to "devour" everything to satisfy our voracity, and being ready to suffer for love, which can fill the emptiness of our hearts. Prayer, which teaches us to abandon idolatry and the self-sufficiency of our ego, and to acknowledge our need of the Lord and his mercy. Almsgiving, whereby we escape from the insanity of hoarding everything for ourselves in the illusory belief that we can secure a future that does not belong to us. And thus to rediscover the joy of God's plan for creation and for each of us, which is to love him, our brothers and sisters, and the entire world, and to find in this love our true happiness. Let us not allow this season of grace to pass in vain! Let us ask God to help us set out on a path of true conversion. Let us leave behind our selfishness and selfabsorption, and turn to Jesus'. Let us stand beside our brothers and sisters in need, sharing our spiritual and material goods with them. In this way, by concretely welcoming Christ's victory over sin and death into our lives, we will also radiate its transforming power to all of creation."

Here are some things we can consider as we get ready for lent (taken from Hallow.com):

Adult Prayer Ideas:

- Join the *Holy Is His Name* Series on Tuesday Nights beginning February 21 at MDP
- Subscribe to a daily Catholic prayer newsletter
- Each morning, scroll through the contacts on your phone. Randomly stop and say a prayer for whichever person you land on
- Spend a few minutes with Scripture each day
- Start the Bible in a Year or Catechism in a Year Podcast with Fr. Mike Schmitz
- Attend daily Mass once a week
- Attend or pray the <u>Stations of the Cross</u> every Friday
- Invite a friend to attend Mass with you
- Attend Adoration of the Eucharist
- Go to confession
- Pray the <u>Rosary</u> once a day

Kids/Teen Prayer Ideas:

- Pray on the way to school
- Play Guess the Saint each day
- Pick a relative each day and pray for that person
- Call a grandparent after church and discuss the Gospel/homily
- Go to bed five minutes early and spend extra time talking with God
- Research the name of your church and learn about its origins
- Pay special attention to the intercessions at Mass and choose one to pray for during the week
- Go to confession

General Ideas for Lenten Sacrifices:

- Give up coffee (or only brew it at home)
- Give up alcohol
- Give up certain social media sites, or limit them to certain days/times
- Give up electronics after a certain time in the day (i.e., no screens after 8 p.m.)
- Park in the back of the parking lot and say a prayer as you walk to the grocery store
- Abstain from reading gossip/rumor sites

Kids / Teen Fasting Ideas:

- Give up a favorite toy or game
- Fast from social media for a day
- Give up a favorite snack
- Drink only water at school
- Give up a favorite chair at home or seat at school
- Go without headphones/air pods for a day
- Play your favorite game, focusing on helping others instead of winning
