Dear Friends,

On this final Sunday of Lent, traditionally named Passion Sunday, we hear Jesus call Lazarus from the Tomb. In the second reading, Paul tells the Romans that if the Spirit of God dwells in them, their mortal bodies will be given life. Centuries before Jesus was born, Ezekiel sees with the eyes of prophecy the day when God will raise the dead.

In the Gospel, we watch as Jesus calls His friend forth from the dead. God gives new life, life that triumphs over death. This is the great message of today's readings: The Lord Jesus releases you from the bondage of sin and promises resurrection and new life to all who believe in Him.

As you immediately make ready to participate in the festival of Holy Week, be assured of our loving support and prayer.

Last week we shared with you our Parish Priorities for Missionary Discipleship, a program in which we have been asked to participate. This week I want to share with you some ideas that were generated from the discussion group on how we could enhance our parishioners' understanding of the faith. Further discussion will need to take place in this regard:

Group teaching and instruction: offer opportunities to study the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

Workshops: Investigate opportunities to participate in available workshops and have parishioners report back what they learned.

Retreats: provide retreat opportunities made easily available and within cost restraints.

Homilies: Find homiletic refresher courses for clergy.

Personal Outreach: begin with offering opportunities to speak with each other about personal relationships with Jesus.

Further discussion among the group members will help clarify and establish goals for each of the discussion points.

Thank you again for your cooperation and willingness to help if the opportunity presents itself. We have such wonderful members of our parish and I am so happy to be a part of your faith life.

MDP SHORE UP THE FUTURE

As of March 20, 2023, we have received \$200,790.50 in donations from 229 families for our 2020 Year 3 Challenge – renovations to the Parish Offices and creation of our Family and Youth Center. FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROTT **Raising from the Dead**

One of the most dramatic scenes that we witness in sacred scripture is the raising of Lazarus from the dead after four days of death. There are three accounts in scripture where Jesus raises people from the dead. The three people Jesus raised from the dead were the widow's son of Nain ([Luke 7:11-17](#)), Jairus' daughter (8:40-56), and [Lazarus \(John 11:1-44\)](#). The raising of Lazarus from the dead is the most dramatic.

Lazarus was a personal friend of Jesus and, as the scriptures remind us, He was deeply perturbed at the passing of Lazarus. One of the great things about our faith is that our God has had lived experiences where He can deeply empathize with our challenges and hardships, especially death.

The three people that Jesus raised from the dead were people He knew, people with whom He had no contact, and family members of friends. These people represented various groups of society and through example showed the universal nature of the church.

All of us know people that have passed and most of us have lost people that are very close to us. Many of us also fear our future death. Jesus didn't raise people from the dead just to show His Lordship, but to show that He has a final authority over all death.

We know that the ultimate way to experience this authority from Christ is not just to intellectually believe that Jesus has great power but to allow Him, while we are here on earth, to release us from our sins. The greatest thing that we can do to show our belief in His power to raise us is to make ourselves available to the sacrament of confession. Please take time during the rest of this Lenten season to examine your conscience and make a good confession. Aside from our regularly scheduled confession on Saturday afternoon, we will have extra times from Palm Sunday through Wednesday of Holy Week. Please allow yourself and invite others to receive this grace even if it has been many years since your last confession.
